Fairtrade is about fairer trading conditions for farmers and workers like you. Fairtrade gives you the opportunity to improve your business and invest in a better future for you and your community.





How you can join



To join Fairtrade, your organization must meet a set of basic criteria and then improve over time. These are organized into social, environmental and business development standards. The Fairtrade standards are designed to benefit you.

An independent company called FLO-CERT inspects your organization and farms to check that you meet the standards. You and your buyers must pass the certification before you can sell your products through Fairtrade.

- If you are a small farmer, you must be organized in a cooperative or formal structure.
- If you work for a plantation, you can sell certain products through Fairtrade if workers are organized and benefit from Fairtrade.
- you do not allow any form of discrimination.
- Your farmers or workers have a voice in decision-making, including how to spend the Fairtrade Premium.
- You are open and honest in the way you run your business.
- You protect the environment.
- Your organization pays and treats workers fairly and follows international labour rights.
- You develop your business for the benefit of members or workers.

Working to support you




Fairtrade International (FLO) and the PSR team
